

**ELGIN EDA  
TREE PLANTING PROGRAM  
50% - 50% Cost Sharing**

The Elgin EDA is again sponsoring the Tree Planting Program. This is an effort by the Elgin EDA to give residents incentive to plant trees. New housing additions are especially urged to participate in the program.

The guidelines and requirements below must be followed to qualify for this program.

**PLANTING PROGRAM:**

- Tree purchase applications will be processed on a first come, first served basis.
- Applications will be issued until budgeted funds are expended.
- Purchaser will pay 50% of the purchase price of the tree.
- Property owners will be able to purchase up to two (2) trees per calendar year.
- Orders will be placed in person at Elgin City office by April 5, 2019.
- The Elgin EDA reserves the right to discontinue this program at any time without notice.
- Additional trees and shrubs are available at full price.

**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:**

- All guidelines and rules must be adhered to.
- A list of available trees as well as shrubs and evergreens can be seen at the Elgin City Office.
- Trees must be planted on City residents' property site.
- Placement of trees on property must be approved by Elgin Public Works.
- It is the responsibility of property owner to locate any underground utilities. Please call Gopher State One Call at 1-800-252-1166 before planting.
- Payment is due in full at time of tree order. Checks will be made payable to Elgin EDA.
- It is the responsibility of the property owner to properly care for and maintain the trees.
- These trees come with no guarantee and there will be no refunds.
